Hiroe Shoni Walker, 90, of Fond du Lac, died on Thursday, February 3, 2022, at her residence.

She was born on January 10, 1932, in Northern Japan. On August 27, 1952, she married Robert B. Walker, at the American Embassy in Japan. They moved from Japan to the United States in 1954, where she has resided in Fond du Lac ever since. Hiroe was a member of Immanuel-Trinity Lutheran Church. She worked as a cook for the Fond du Lac School District. She loved her family and enjoyed traveling to Niagara Falls, Japan and Mexico.
