Howard A. Bellmer, 86, of 438 North Peters Avenue, Fond du Lac, died Sunday, May 16, 2010, at St. Agnes Hospital. He was born on the Bellmer Homestead, in the Town of Friendship, on June 26, 1923, a son of Clyde E. and Martha G. Arenz Bellmer. He graduated in 1941 from Horace Mann High School, North Fond du Lac. Howard served with the United States Air Force from November 1942 until November 1945 in the European Theater. On January 4, 1947, he married LaVerne R. Orvis. He farmed in the Town of Lamartine for five years and then for 34 years he worked as a milk procurement field man for Borden Galloway West Division, Fond du Lac. Howard was a member of St. Paul's Ev. Lutheran Church, North Fond du Lac, where he was the "adopted grandfather" and "candyman" for the children of the congregation. He was also a member of the American Legion Bintzeler Waehler Post 347, Lomira. He is survived by his wife, LaVerne Bellmer; three children: Bridget Oelke of Fond du Lac, Michael (Sue) Bellmer of Fond du Lac, and Peter (Tami) Bellmer of Argyle, Texas; nine grandchildren: Scott (Kristin) Boevers, Brian (Mary) Boevers, J.D. (Aimee) Oelke, Tabitha (Scott) Herbst, Angela (Todd) Cardinal, Michelle (Duane) Hass, Amy Ott, Lisa (Nick) Fowlkes, and Brittany (Roman) Wrobel; thirteen great-grandchildren; and a sister, Marjorie Steffes of Oshkosh. He was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers: Kenneth and Elmore Bellmer; and a nephew, Steven Bellmer. The funeral service will be at noon on Thursday, May 20, 2010, at St. Paul's Ev.
