



## Hubert G. Hodorff

March 13, 1934 - July 15, 2008

Hubert G. Hodorff, 74, of W7729 Chelen Ridge, Van Dyne, died Tuesday, July 15, 2008, at home following a yearlong battle with cancer. He was born on March 13, 1934, in the Town of Osceola, a son of John S. and Esther S. (nee Dennert) Hodorff. He served with the United States Army from 1957 - 1959. On July 11, 1959, he married Hazel J. Barfknecht and together they celebrated 49 years of marriage. He worked for 42 years as a truck driver for Henry Timblin.
