



## Irene C. Ehrhardt

August 28, 1916 - January 26, 2010

Irene C. Ehrhardt, 93, a resident of the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home, formerly of Rosendale, died Tuesday, January 26, 2010. She was born on August 28, 1916, in Oak Creek, Wisconsin, a daughter of Levi and Martha Block Esch. Irene graduated from Bayview High School, Milwaukee. Prior to her marriage, she was employed as a beautician. On June 8, 1940, she married Willard F. Ehrhardt, in Oak Creek, Wisconsin. The couple bought a farm in Racine County in 1941, and later moved to Rosendale in 1968. Irene was a clerk and served as acting Postmaster at Caledonia Post Office from 1958-1968. In her early years, Irene was active in 4-H. In later years, she was involved with Homemakers and Mothers Clubs. She was a former member of the Union Grove Chapter of Order of Eastern Star. She served as a state officer and later became Worthy Matron. In her retirement years, she and Willard enjoyed traveling, playing cards, and visiting their friends and family. She was a member of Rosendale United Church of Christ. She is survived by a son, David Ehrhardt of Rosendale; three grandsons: Daniel Ehrhardt of Rosendale, Donald (Pamela) Ehrhardt and their daughter, Morgan of Rosendale, and Michael (Tracey) Ehrhardt and their children: Connor, Kane, Abbey and Abe of Lomira; a daughter-in-law, Margaret Ehrhardt of Rosendale; two sisters-in-law: Delores Esch of Oak Creek, and LaVerne Ehrhardt of Lomira. Irene is further survived by nieces, nephews, and cousins. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Willard on December 19, 1982; two infant sisters, Margaret and Lois; a sister, Florence (Fred) Brinkman; two brothers: Wesley

(Harriet) Esch, and Gordon Esch; a grandson, Jeffrey Ehrhardt; and a great-grandson, Jonathan Ehrhardt. Following Irene's request, entombment has taken place. A memorial service will be held at noon, on Monday, February 1, 2010, at Shrine of Rest Mausoleum chapel at Ledgeview Memorial Park, N6250 County Road K, Fond du Lac, with Rev. Peter Brinkman officiating. The family will greet friends and relatives on Monday at Shrine of Rest Mausoleum chapel from 10:00 a.m. until the time of service.
