Irma M. Draves, 99, of Fond du Lac, died on Sunday, October 15, 2023, at the Lutheran Home.

She was born on July 9, 1924, a daughter of Alfred and Esther Madaus Abraham, in a farmhouse in the Town of Black Wolf, her grandmother, Wilhelmina Abraham served as the midwife. She was number five of ten children. Irma was baptized, confirmed, and graduated from St. John's Lutheran in Nekimi. On June 1, 1946, she married Louis E. Draves at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, they were married for 53 years, until his death on August 21, 1999. They were blessed with seven children.

Irma worked at Diamond Drive-In, Wells Manufacturing, and the Dartmoor Hotel, as the head housekeeper for over a decade. They managed the Forest Avenue Apartments for years. Irma was a loyal domestic employee for 30 years. Irma retired from playing baseball with her grandchildren at the age of 91. She was a member of Immanuel-Trinity Lutheran Church.
