Jack E. Hawley, 74, of Fond du Lac, was called home by his Lord on Sunday, April 6, 2008, at Hospice Home of Hope, Fond du Lac, with his family by his side. He was born on April 17, 1933, in Milwaukee, a son of Vivian and Edna Olson Hawley. On May 9, 1953, he married Betty J. Wright at St. Mary Help of Christians Rectory in West Allis. They shared 54 wonderful years together. Jack served with the United States Army during the Korean Conflict, stationed primarily in Ladd Airforce Base in Fairbanks, Alaska.
