



## James Francis Wick

August 6, 1942 - January 12, 2009

James Francis Wick, 66, of Fond du Lac, Wis., died Monday, Jan. 12, 2009, after a battle with prostate cancer. He was born Aug. 6, 1942, the son of Edwin F. and Marie M. (Bednarek) Wick of Princeton, Wis. He attended Princeton schools, graduating from Princeton High School in 1960. He began work through a machinist apprentice program at Giddings & Lewis Co. in Fond du Lac, Wis., and worked there for many years. Jim was an all-around handyman who could fix most anything. As a young man, he enjoyed spending time with his father working at the farm and airplane hangar, and raced a boat on the Fox River in the Princeton area. But his passion was muscle cars and drag racing. Jim built a winning record at Wisconsin International Raceway in Kaukauna, Wis., and Great Lakes Dragaway in Union Grove, Wis., and garnered sponsorships from Chrysler, Road America and Packer City Plymouth of Green Bay, Wis. He followed national competitive racing circuits including the NHRA (National Hot Rod Association) and UDRA (United Drag Racer Association). Among his many trophies are awards for SS/A class winner at the 1970 NHRA U.S. Nationals and SS/A class winner at the 1971 NHRA Winter Nationals. In 1972, Jim won five UDRA Pro Stock events, was first or second qualifier at 25 out of 49 events and was Pro Stock points champion. His racing team won best appearing car and crew several years in a row, and was recognized as Hot Rod Magazine's best appearing car and crew in 1971. Many fellow racers sought advice from Jim, and in 1966, he started Jim's Car Shop, providing technical assistance and high performance

parts to the racing industry. The shop, now operated by his son Jeff, continues to grow its business today. In 1973, Jim was critically injured at an NHRA race in Columbus, Ohio. A spinal cord injury left him a quadriplegic. After the accident, his fellow racers held a benefit for him at Great Lakes Dragaway, and the communities in Ohio and Fond du Lac stepped up to help the family. Through all of this, his passion for racing carried on. Over the years, he partnered with (the late) Jim Jezewski and Tim Mayhew, and for the last 25 years his son Jeff, to drive his race cars. He relished in seeing his cars compete and masterminding the fine-tuning to make them faster and better. Jim is preceded in death by his father, Edwin, and his brother, Gary. He is survived by his children Jeff (Carmen) Wick, of Fond du Lac, Wis., Alan Wick of Richfield, Wis., and Joy Wick of Appleton, Wis.; grandchildren Jordan and Bryce Wick of Fond du Lac, Wis.; his mother, Marie Wick, of Princeton, Wis.; his brother Doug (Michelle) of Cedar Rapids, Iowa; nephews Dan (Kim) Wick, of Washington, D.C., and Josh and Noah Wick of Cedar Rapids, Iowa; his former wife, Lois Wick of Fond du Lac, Wis.; a special nephew Paul Hoppman of Fond du Lac, Wis., and extensive family and friends. The family will greet friends and relatives from 5 to 7 p.m. Friday, Jan. 23, 2009, at Sacred Heart Church, 232 S. Peters Ave., Fond du Lac. The Mass of Christian Burial will follow at 7 p.m. with Rev. Victor Capriolo officiating. A Mass of Christian Burial also will be held Monday, Jan. 26, 2009, at 11 a.m. at St. John the Baptist Church in Princeton, Wis., with the Rev. Dale Grubba officiating. Visitation will be held from 10 a.m. to the time of the Mass. Burial will take place at a later date at St. John the Baptist Cemetery in Princeton, Wis.
