Janice Marie “Granny Smith” Smith, 55, a resident of Fond du Lac, died Saturday, July 12, 2008, at Agnesian Healthcare Hospice Home of Hope. Janice was born on April 18, 1953, the daughter of Aldo and Marie St. Onge Visintin. She attended St. Joseph’s Grade School and was a 1971 graduate of L.P. Goodrich High School. She later graduated from MPTI where she earned her nursing license.
