Jerome "Jerry" B. Schmitz, 82, of Fond du Lac, died on Monday, August 14, 2023, at St. Agnes Hospital.

He was born on June 14, 1941, in Johnsburg, Wisconsin, the son of Thomas and Adeline Pickart Schmitz. On September 26, 1981, he married Marsha L. Comeaux, in Fond du Lac.

In Jerry's early years, he farmed at various farms in the community.
