April 21, 1915 - January 25, 2017

A loving mother and grandmother, Josephine "Josie" C. Peachy, 101, of the town of Lamartine, went to her heavenly home on Wednesday, January 25, 2017. One of 16 children, Josephine was born on April 21, 1915, in Park Falls, the daughter of the late Delbert and Helen (Mayleth) Tollard.
