Joyce M. Braun, 77, passed peacefully in her sleep. As her family lovingly looks back at her life and legacy, we are honored to share some of her story. Joyce was born in Fond du Lac on August 23, 1946 to Howard and Dolores Freiberg, whom she is now reunited with. She grew up on Wisconsin Avenue just a couple blocks away from the Soo Line. Her wit, humor, kindness, and boundless energy always drew people to her. Joyce was homecoming queen at Horace Mann High School in 1964 and the words next to her senior picture read “Ever willing to assist, and her charm we can’t resist.” A lifetime later, those words still hold true. Being both business-minded and a bit audacious, she began her career working in the Register of Deeds office in Fond du Lac. Later, she moved to Madison where she established herself in real estate. While she was passionate about her work, it was her family she cherished most. She married and had a son, Scott Braun in 1969. A son that grew from her beloved little boy into a kind, creative and dependable family man. Joyce later found the love of her life, Roger Wayne Koby. He passed in a plane crash on March 19, 1975, just a few months before their daughter Rogette was born. A daughter with the same charm, boundless energy and determination as her mom. Later in life, Rogette would take her father’s last name, Koby. Both Scott and Rogette have four children between them whom “Grandma Joy” adored. Joyce’s love and light touched many lives beyond her own children and grandchildren.
