Judith A. Stephany, 69, of North Fond du Lac, died Friday, August 12, 2011, at home. Judy was born a daughter of Francis and Ann Kaiser Willis on October 2, 1941, in Fond du Lac. She graduated in 1959 from North Fond du Lac High School. After graduation, she obtained her diploma from Columbia Hospital School of Nursing, Milwaukee, a BSN from Marian College, Fond du Lac, and a MSN from the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh. She was a registered nurse for Agnesian Healthcare-Sharpe Clinic for 42 years. On August 24, 1964, she married Paul S. Stephany. Judy was a member of St. Paul's Ev. Lutheran Church, North Fond du Lac, and the ladies society, called Wings. She was also a member of the Wisconsin and American Nurses Association. Judy was a former volunteer for the North Fond du Lac EMS. She enjoyed bicycling, reading, baking desserts, and a love for dogs. She is survived by her husband, Paul; two sons: Paul G.
