Junice "June" Marie Oberbeck, 91, of Fond du Lac, she fell asleep in her Savior's arms on Saturday, January 2, 2016, at Grancare Nursing and Rehabilitation. She was born on December 11, 1924, in Fond du Lac, a daughter of Frederick E. and Emily M. Immel Supple. Junice was a graduate of Winnebago Lutheran Academy, Class of 1942. She continued her education at Sheboygan County Teachers College in Sheboygan Falls for two years. She was an elementary school teacher at Ledgeview School, in the Town of Taycheedah, teaching grades first through eighth, from 1945-1948, when the school closed. She went on to teach at Brookside School, in the Town of Byron, from 1949-1951, and later became a substitute teacher at Elizabeth Waters School, in Fond du Lac, for one year, until her husband, Norm, began his military service in Colorado Springs, Colorado. Junice was a homemaker, taking good care of her husband and her son. She enjoyed gardening, flowers, and her artwork. On September 10, 1949, she married Norman D. Oberbeck, at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac. She is survived by a son, Gerritt J. Oberbeck of Fond du Lac; three nephews: Robert Supple of Fort Collins, Colorado, James (Patty) Supple of Fond du Lac, and Tom Supple of Tomahawk; five great-nephews: Matthew, David, Steven, Michael, and Mark Supple; one great-niece, Kim Supple; and four great-great-nephews; and three great-great-nieces.
