On July 27, 2024, Heaven gained a warrior! Kathleen M Ruch, after almost 3 years of a fearless fight against lymphoma with numerous different treatments, passed away peacefully with loved ones beside her.

Kathy was born on November 8, 1949, at St Agnes Hospital, Fond du Lac, to Lyle and Eunice (Pfeiffer) Tabbert. She was baptized and confirmed at St Peter's Ev Lutheran Church, Eldorado. She graduated from Winnebago Lutheran Academy, Fond du Lac, where she met her husband of 50 years, Rueben Ruch, Jr, who preceded her in death in 2020. After marrying Rueb on July 12, 1969, she focused on supporting her family. She had multiple jobs in her life, but her favorite was being a mom and grandmother.
