Kenneth L. Hills, Sr., 78, of 143 Willis Court, North Fond du Lac, died Wednesday, October 18, 2006. He was born on October 20, 1927, in Neenah, Wisconsin, a son of Maurice and Edith Wallender Hills. Ken served with the United States Marines during World War II and later with the United States Army. He was an avid war historian and enjoyed building radio-controlled model airplanes. On September 19, 1952, he married Joyce Ann Hall at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, North Fond du Lac. Ken had been employed with the Chicago Northwestern Railroad prior to his retirement.
