Kenneth J. Peachy, 70, of 106 North Seymour Street, Fond du Lac, and most recently a resident at the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home, was called to his heavenly home on Thursday, February 22, 2007, following a courageous battle with ALS. He was born on July 29, 1936, in Fond du Lac, a son of James and Lorina Gohlke Peachy. He graduated as president of his class from Winnebago Lutheran Academy in 1955. Following high school, he served in the United States Army Reserve. On June 15, 1958, he married Mary F. Koester. Kenneth owned and operated Ken's Meats for many years. He was a self-made businessman. After selling his meat market, he worked for the Fond du Lac School District as warehouse manager from 1979-1998. He was a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac, and a lifelong member of the Fond du Lac Yacht Club. He was an avid fisherman and outdoorsman and enjoyed boating. Kenneth was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather. He was very proud of his family and always placed them as his first priority as he remained faithful to God throughout his life.
