Laurence "Larry" "Little Larry" J. Secord III, 54, of Fond du Lac died on Sunday, July 22, 2018, from complications of Cerebral Palsy, at Hospice Home of Hope, surrounded by his loving family.

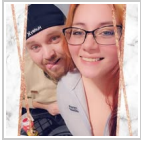
