Leigh-Ann Noel Balthazor, 34, died unexpectedly Wednesday, September 16, 2015, at St. Mary's Hospital in Madison. She was born on December 4, 1980, the daughter of David and Mary Balthazor, Fond du Lac. Leigh-Ann graduated from Goodrich High School in 1999 and from the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point in 2004, and attended Concordia University, Madison for her teaching degree. Leigh-Ann was a talented pianist and she presently taught piano at Monroe Street Art Center in Madison and was planning her wedding. She is survived by her parents; her fiancé, Matthew Dahm of Madison; a sister and brother-in-law, Jessica and Patrick Bunkert and their children, of Fond du Lac; a brother and sister-in-law, Tony and Amy Balthazor and their children, of Oshkosh; many aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends.
