Lloyd G. Ott, 77, of Eldorado, died peacefully at his home on Thursday, December 17, 2015. He was born on November 5, 1938, in the Town of Eldorado, the son of George and Nathaleen Dunn Ott. He was baptized November 23, 1938, and confirmed in the Christian faith on May 6, 1951, in the Evangelical United Brethren Church. Lloyd graduated from Rosendale High School, Class of 1956. Lloyd served with the United States National Guard. On July 10, 1965, he married Janice B. Steinert at St. John's Lutheran Church, Oshkosh, with Rev. E. W. Rabe officiating. Lloyd worked on the family farm and continued working there, as well as working at Oshkosh Truck for 34 years, retiring in 2002. Lutheran Church, Nekimi, where he served on the church council, as a trustee for three terms. He taught Sunday school with his mentor, Tuffy, ushered for many years, and was the ushering team captain. Also, he belonged to St. John's Senior Saints. After his retirement, he took a 30 day trip to Alaska, which he loved. He enjoyed hunting, gardening, and his birds.
