Sunday, August 17, 2014, Lois went home to heaven, arriving in time for the 9:15 a.m. service. Her family tearfully, yet peacefully, celebrated her home-going at her hospital bedside. Each and every family member, whether there in person or spirit, knew without a doubt, she had joined the great cloud of witnesses that continues to cheer us on. She was born on March 23, 1935, in Fond du Lac, a daughter of Harold H. and Nina L. Titel Hills. On April 24, 1954 Robert "Bob" Carl Baumhardt and Lois Marie Hills were married and embarked upon a full life of living "happily ever after". At the beginning of June, 2014, Lois was able to fulfill a life-long wish by taking a trip overseas with her daughter, Julie, and son-in-law, Gary, to Brussels, Belgium; Aachen, Germany, and Paris, France. One month later, July 19, 2014, she and Bob celebrated their diamond wedding anniversary of 60 years at the Eden Community Center.
