Lorraine M. Gantner, 93, a resident of Adelaide Place, Fond du Lac, died Friday, October 23, 2015. She was born a daughter of the late William G. and Clara E. Broetzmann Krug, on May 3, 1922, in Van Dyne. Lorraine attended grade school at St. Paul's Lutheran School in the Town of Forest, where she was confirmed in the Lutheran faith. Lorraine married Herbert J. Gantner on May 5, 1945, at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac. She worked with her husband on the Gantner farm on Highway 45, until they moved to County Road B. Lorraine worked for five years at the shoe factory in Lomira, and then the upholstery business, first at Fond du Lac Mattress Company, and then for many years out of her home. Lorraine enjoyed attending church at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac, and was a member there until her death. She also enjoyed hunting and fishing with her husband, taking rides throughout the area, and visiting with family and friends.
