Louella M. Wagner Kirschenstein, 93, a resident of the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home, died Thursday, March 27, 2008. She was born on December 31, 1914, in the Town of Greenbush, Sheboygan County, a daughter of William C. and Anna Mehre. Louella attended Hulls Crossing Grade School and graduated from Glenbeulah High School, Class of 1932. On September 14, 1935, she married Norman G. Wagner at Zion Lutheran Church, Glenbeulah. Together they farmed in the Town of Empire until his death on October 3, 1977. She was united in marriage to Elmer W. Kirschenstein on February 14, 1981. They resided in Fond du Lac. He preceded her in death on October 25, 2001. Louella was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Town of Forest. She is survived by three children: Lois (Frank) Krug of Fond du Lac, Mary (Tom) Rauls of Tuscon, Arizona, Charles (Lorraine) Wagner of Sun Lakes, Arizona; 13 grandchildren; and 19 great-grandchildren.
