Lucille "Cile" H. O'Neil, 91, formerly of Eldorado and Rosendale area, died peacefully and surrounded by family, on Monday, April 28, 2014. Her later years, she resided at the Willowbrook Apartments in Ripon and most recently at the Patriot Place in Berlin.

She was born on September 3, 1922, in the Town of Eldorado, the daughter of Edward C. and Hazel A. Henke Manzke. She graduated from Rosendale Union Free High School in 1940, where she was active in many things. She did housework in order to stay in school.

On June 18, 1941, she married Arlyn D. O'Neil at St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Eldorado. They were married 58 years at the time of Arlyn's death in 1999.

Lucille worked at Rosendale Shopping Center for 35 years. She helped at the Eldorado Fireman's picnic for many years, and was an avid oil painter of scenery and flowers, and she loved to play cards.
