



Lynn "Lindy" N. Woodruff

August 10, 1950 - December 5, 2022

Lynn "Lindy" Rust Woodruff, ascended to Heaven peacefully on Monday, December 5, 2022, at St. Agnes Hospital, after a courageous two-year battle with cancer with her loving husband and son by her side.

Lindy was born August 10th, 1950, in Sheboygan, WI to Jay and Irene "Granny" Rust. Lindy graduated from Goodrich High School, Class of 1968. Afterwards, she attended U.W. Oshkosh, then traveled Europe for six months. She lived in Florida and Arizona before returning to Fond du Lac where she was employed at Howard Johnson's and ended her serving career at the Retlaw Hotel. In the fall of 1977, on a blind date at the Lamartine Tavern for a Friday Fish Fry, she met "Skipper," the love of her life for over 45 years. On June 28th, 1985 they were united in marriage at Church of Peace Lutheran in Fond du Lac.

Lindy's biggest enjoyment was being on the water with her husband, son, and her boating friends. She loved watching the Green Bay Packers while occasionally having a "cold one," but her biggest passion was cooking, especially making soups. She loved animals with all her heart, especially cats.

She is survived by her husband, James "Skipper" Woodruff, and her loving son, James "J.C." Woodruff II; niece Amy (Anthony) Wachewicz; nephew Jay (Jodi) Rust, and their children Avery, Mia, and Declan.

She is preceded in death by her parents Jay and Irene “Granny” Rust, brother Jay “Tom” Rust, and sister-in-law Sheila Rust.

Per Lindy’s request cremation has taken place. Her family will fulfill her wishes with a private ceremony to be held at Kurki Funeral Chapel.
