January 20, 1914 - August 18, 2010

Marcella M. Vetter, 96, died Wednesday, August 18, 2010, at Hospice Home of Hope, Fond du Lac. She was born on January 20, 1914, in the Town of Eldorado, a daughter of Edward W. and Anna J. Henning Kemnitz. Marcella was baptized on February 8, 1914 and confirmed on April 6, 1927, in Eldorado. She graduated from Winnebago Lutheran Academy in 1932, and Fond du Lac County Normal School in 1933. Her early teaching career was in a one room school house in the Woodhull area for four years. She later taught at St. Paul's Lutheran School, North Fond du Lac from 1958-1963, and St. Peter's Lutheran School, Fond du Lac from 1964 until retiring in 1979. On September 18, 1937, she married Friedhold E. Vetter. Marcella was a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac. She was an active volunteer in the Elderly Nutrition Program. She is survived by three children: Rosalie Jensen of Fairmont, Minnesota, Kurtis (Donna) Vetter of Fond du Lac, and Gordon (Sally) Vetter of New London; eight grandchildren: Scott (Joanne) Vetter, Traci (Andy) Luther, Diana (Laurence) Cramer, Nick Vetter, Dean (Heidi) Vetter, Cara (Jason) Menz, Luke (Jacqueline) Vetter, and Kyle (Knatalie) Vetter; 16 great-grandchildren; and a sister, Lucille Krug of Waupun. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Friedhold, in 1966; a son-in-law, James Jensen; a brother, Chet Kemnitz; and two sisters: Katherine Zellers and Marion Wegner. The funeral service will be held at 1:30 p.m. on Friday, August 20, 2010, at Redeemer Lutheran Church, 606 Forest Avenue, Fond du Lac, with Rev. Fred Toppe officiating. Burial will follow
