



## Margaret Kaul Porter

November 14, 1921 - May 1, 2011

Margaret Kaul Porter, 89, of Fond du Lac, died Sunday, May 1, 2011, at St. Francis Home. She was born on November 14, 1921, in Holly Oak, Delaware, a daughter of Calvin S. and Mary Wilkins Albee. Margaret grew up in Franklin, New Hampshire, later moving to New York City, where she graduated from Haaren High School in 1940. She continued her education at Englewood Hospital School of Nursing in Englewood City, New Jersey, where she graduated as a registered nurse in 1944. Margaret made many lifelong friends during nurses training. They kept in touch through the years, although many miles separated them. She served with the United States Army at Fort Dix, New Jersey, near the end of World War II. She later became a Head Nurse at New York Presbyterian Hospital. On April 25, 1953, she married Wilson H. Kaul in New York City. The couple moved to Fond du Lac in 1954, where their four children were born and raised. Wilson preceded her in death on June 22, 1973. She married Frank P. Porter on October 15, 1983. He preceded her in death on June 17, 1986. Margaret devoted her life to her family. She was a very generous, easygoing, kind, and loving person. She enjoyed traveling, reading, gardening, and eating ice cream. She was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Fond du Lac, for over 50 years. She is survived by four children: Robert W. Kaul of Fond du Lac, Susan E. Kaul James of North Fond du Lac, Nancy L. Kaul of Fond du Lac, and Thomas A. (Joan) Kaul of Baraboo; two granddaughters: Heidi A. Burns and Stacy M. James (fiancé Jonathan Hitesman); and a great-granddaughter, Arianna E. Burns. She was

preceded in death by her parents; a brother, Robert W.
