Marlene A. Pinkert, 85, of Fond du Lac, passed away on Wednesday, February 24, 2021, at St. Agnes Hospital.

She was born on August 10, 1935, in Fond du Lac, the daughter of Paul J. and Anna P. Bahr Kleinschmidt.
