Marlow E. Potratz, 75, of W8047 County Road N, Van Dyne, died Thursday, March 26, 2009, at St. Agnes Hospital, Fond du Lac. He was born on October 25, 1933, in Fond du Lac, a son of Ervin and Erna Albrecht Potratz. Marlow graduated from Rosendale High School in 1951 and married Shirley Miller in 1953 at Peace Lutheran Church, Rosendale. She preceded him in death in 1978. Marlow married Marlene Wagner on September 3, 1979, at First Baptist Church in Waukegan, Illinois, and this coming September, they would have celebrated 30 years of marriage. Marlow worked as a dairy farmer and hauled milk.
