



Rev. Marvin Putz

November 20, 1927 - June 21, 2010

Rev. Marvin Putz, 82, a resident of Fond du Lac, died on Monday, June 21, 2010, at Mercy Medical Center, Oshkosh. He was born on November 20, 1927, in Fountain City, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, a son of John and Esther Lorenz Putz. He was a graduate of Northwestern College, Watertown class of 1951, and Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary, Mequon class of 1954. On June 5, 1952, he married Edna E. Miller at St. Michael's Lutheran Church, Fountain City. Following graduation, he served as pastor of the following congregations: Grace Lutheran Church, Casa Grande, Arizona; St. Paul Lutheran Church, Valley City, North Dakota; Ascension Lutheran Church, Moorehead, Minnesota; Redeemer Lutheran Church, Mandan, North Dakota; Mountain View Lutheran Church, Great Falls, Montana; Redeemer Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac from 1975-1993; and St. Peter Lutheran Church, Eldorado from 1994 until his retirement in 2006. Rev. Putz was a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac. He is survived by his wife, Edna; four children: Rev. David (Susan) Putz of St. Petersburg, Florida; Rita (Tim) Geary of Sheridan, Wyoming; Judy (Paul) Maasz of Sleepy Eye, Minnesota; and Mary (Mark) Otterstatter of Fond du Lac; 21 grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; a brother, Merlin (Elaine) Putz; and a sister-in-law, Iva Putz. He was preceded in death by his parents; a daughter, Karen Dietz; a son, Dale Putz; a granddaughter, Robin Dietz; and a brother, Leonard Putz. The funeral service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 26, 2010, at Redeemer Lutheran Church, 606 Forest Avenue, Fond du Lac, with the Rev. Fred Toppe

officiating. Burial will be in Buffalo City Cemetery, Buffalo County, Wisconsin with the Rev. Elroy Conradt officiating. The visitation will be from 4-8 p.m. on Friday, June 25, 2010, at church and on Saturday at church from 9:00 a.m. until the time of service.
