Mary Frances Merwin, 60, of Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, passed away at home on Monday, Oct. 11, 2010. She was born in Chicago, Ill., on Nov. 12, 1949, a daughter of James Patrick and Mary Claire Sullivan. She completed her undergraduate studies in education at Edgewood College in Madison, Wis. She received her master's degree in educational leadership from Marian College in Fond du Lac. On Nov. 27, 1971, she married Gary Lee Merwin at St. Thomas More Catholic Church in Munster, Ind. She is survived by her husband, Gary; two daughters, Katherine Hareid (Aaron) and Margaret Merwin, both of Minneapolis, Minn.; two sons, Joseph Merwin (Sandra) of Jacksonville, Fla. and Luke Merwin of Minneapolis, Minn.; three grandchildren, Ava Hareid, Henry Hareid and Eliannah Merwin.
