Nancy J. Anderson, 88, of Neenah, died on Tuesday, August 29, 2023, at ThedaCare Regional Medical Center.

Nancy enjoyed sewing and at the early age of 14, she had saved enough money to buy her first Pfaff sewing machine. This soon became her passion, and she would often use her talent to help others. She was a very gifted seamstress, doing alterations for bridal shops and eventually making both of

her daughters' wedding gowns and bridesmaids dresses. It soon became a full-time venture for her, working out of her home. Nancy especially cherished her long-time friendship with Mary Benson. She always looked forward to their every Wednesday phone conversations.

She is survived by two children: Diana Corbin "Dewey", Paul Nelson "Hippie"; her daughter-in-law Laura Nelson; grandchildren: Justin Brietzke, Jill Wilke, Tyler Corbin, Matthew (Alex) Nelson, and Sara Nelson; 8 great-grandchildren, 3 great-great grandchildren; a sister: Judy Hahn; and many nieces and nephews.
