Nicholas O. Wessel, 45, of 420 Amory Street, Fond du Lac, died Thursday, October 14, 2010, at Hospice Home of Hope, Fond du Lac. He was born on February 23, 1965, in Graceville, Minnesota, a son of Roger H. and Alice M. Eichsteadt Wessel. Nick was baptized at Trinity Ev. Lutheran Church in Johnson, Minnesota, and was confirmed in 1979, at Zion Ev. Lutheran Church in Columbus, Wisconsin. Nick graduated from Winnebago Lutheran Academy in 1983 and then received an accounting degree from Moraine Park Technical Institute in 1985. He played the tuba for over 26 years with the Fond du Lac Symphonic Band and other brass groups at numerous community events. He was a member of a recorder ensemble, Pembroke Players. He was employed many years at Piggly Wiggly where he greeted everyone with a friendly smile and enjoyed visiting with the customers. When he was not at work, he enjoyed gardening and cooking. Nick was a member of St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac. He is survived by his mother, Alice Wessel; four brothers and a sister: Sherwood (Beth) Wessel of St. James, Minnesota, Nathan Wessel of Fond du Lac, Dr. Jeremy Wessel of Thibodaux, Louisiana, Rev. Benjamin (Lynn) Wessel of West Allis, and Heidi (Bruce) Zabel of Fond du Lac; seven nieces and nephews: David (Marci) Wessel, Kristina (Caleb) Troge, Faith Bases, and Rachel Wessel, and Josiah, Hannah, and Jedidiah Zabel; and a great-nephew, Nathanael Wessel.
