Norma R. McAuly, 71, of 241 Chestnut Street, Fond du Lac, died Monday, May 10, 2010, at home. She was born on September 8, 1938, in Atlanta, Georgia, a daughter of Franklin and Ruth Weed Bell. She grew up in Manchester, GA and graduated from Manchester High School in 1956. Norma earned a Bachelor of Science degree and a minor in Math from LaGrange College, LaGrange, GA in 1960. On August 6, 1961, she married Robert R. McAuly in Manchester, GA. Norma's first teaching position was at Campbellsport High School for three years. She went on to teach advanced math at Horace Mann High School, North Fond du Lac for 31 years, retiring in 1995. She was a member of the Wisconsin Historical Society and an avid genealogist. Norma enjoyed getting together with her special Bumblebee friends. She is survived by her husband, Robert "Bob" McAuly of Fond du Lac; a nephew, Steven (Linda) Bell; two nieces: Lynn (Dennis) Reynolds, and Sheila (Chris) Carlisle; special cousins: Bill and Mary Jo Hay, Lloyd and Kathleen Hay, Dorothy Couch, and Patricia Simmons, all of GA; together with numerous great nieces and nephews.
