January 30, 1916 - September 3, 2011

Norma I. Schroeder, 95, of Fond du Lac, died Saturday, September 3, 2011, at St. Agnes Hospital. She was born on January 30, 1916, in the Town of Byron, the daughter of Ferdinand A. and Marie L. Hoppe Guelzow. Norma graduated from Fond du Lac Senior High School in 1933. On November 25, 1943, she married Arthur J. Schroeder at St. Luke's Lutheran Church, Oakfield.
