November 23, 1961 - January 20, 2018

Norman "Norm" "Bumpa" L. Huff, 56, of Rosendale, died unexpectedly on Saturday, January 20, 2018, doing what he enjoyed, working outdoors.

He was born on November 23, 1961, in Watersville, Maine, the son of Dennis and Eunice (Brooks) Huff. He graduated from Laconia High School, on May 27, 1981. On May 29, 1981, he married Pamela J. Boeck, at Salem United Methodist Church in Eldorado.

Norm worked at Morgan Doors for over 15 years, then worked at Quad Graphics for over 15 years, and was currently employed at Oshkosh Corporation. 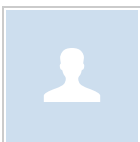
