Orin Roy Treadwell, 91, of Fond du Lac, died Sunday, December 14, 2014, at St. Francis Terrace. He was born on June 6, 1923 in Fond du Lac to the late George and Mildred Treadwell. He graduated from Fond du Lac Senior High School in 1941. Roy enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps in 1942, serving as a radar engineer on B-17s and served until 1946.
