Orlin A. Pucker, 74, formerly of Eldorado, died Wednesday, September 19, 2007, at All About Life Rehabilitation Center, Fond du Lac. He was born on December 11, 1932, in the Town of Lamartine, a son of George and Nellie Burgraff Pucker. He attended Perry School. Then he joined his father on the family farm, which he owned until his retirement in 1993 due to complications from a severe stroke in April of 1993. On May 12, 1956, he married Marlene D. Morgan, at St. Stephen's Lutheran Church, Rogersville, of which he presently was a member. He was an avid sportsman and enjoyed hunting, fishing, and camping in his spare time. He was a former member of the Lamartine Volunteer Fire Department and Ducks Unlimited.
