Otto H. Zupke, 90, of 81 Warner Street, Fond du Lac, died Thursday, August 26, 2010, at St. Luke's Medical Center, Milwaukee. He was born on January 29, 1920, in Marblehead, a son of Otto H. and Una C. Nast Zupke. Otto proudly served with the United States Army in the European Theater during World War II from 1942-1946.
