Patricia "Pat" R. Schwalbe, a loving wife, mother and grandmother, of Oshkosh, was born into eternal life on Thursday, November 25, 2021, with her loving husband by her side.

She was born on September 8, 1943, in Manitowoc, WI, the daughter of Carl H. and Phyllis D. (Johnson) Meyers. She was baptized on October 16, 1943 and confirmed in her faith in April of 1957, both at First German Ev. Lutheran Church in Manitowoc. On August 22, 1964, she married Russell L. Schwalbe, at First German Ev. Lutheran Church in Manitowoc.
