Paul R. Rusch, 91, of Racine and formerly of Fond du Lac, died Friday, September 3, 2010, at the Clement J. Zablocki Veterans Affairs Medical Center, Milwaukee. He was born on December 15, 1918, in Fond du Lac, a son of Reinholdt and Erna Bruett Rusch. Paul was a 1936 graduate of Fond du Lac Senior High School and then served in the United States Army Air Corp. On November 10, 1945, he married Leone Jaskie at Church of Our Saviour with Rev. B.J.
