Richard "Rick" C. Parent, 62, of Beaver Dam, formerly of Fond du Lac, died Thursday, December 18, 2008, at home. He was born on November 29, 1946, in Fond du Lac, a son of Arthur "Buck" and Beverly Biedermann Parent. He served in the United States Army in Vietnam from 1968 – 1970.
