Richard H. Schuff, 86, of North Fond du Lac, died Saturday, July 18, 2015, at Mercy Medical Center, Oshkosh. He was born on May 21, 1929, in Oshkosh, a son of Henry and Margaret Hannes Schuff. He graduated from Oshkosh High School and served a four year metal patternmaker apprenticeship with Diamond Patternworks.
