Robert Greuel, 82, of New Holstein, died on Friday, December 22, 2023, at Lake House in New Holstein.

He was born on October 4, 1941, the son of Roland and Ruth Brantmeier Greuel. Robert attended UW-Milwaukee for undergraduate and University of Nebraska-Omaha where he received his Master's degree in Geography. On May 23, 1970, he married Jacquelyn A. Borcyk, at St. Rose Church in Genoa, Nebraska. She preceded him in death on September 17, 2019.

Robert was a professor at UW-Oshkosh and owned/operated his dad's milk hauling business. He was a past member of the WI Milk Haulers Association and National Milk Haulers Association. Robert enjoyed traveling, camping, and photography. He traveled to all 50 states, driving to Alaska, and most recently traveled to Labrador.

He is survived by his son Burton Greuel of Appleton, his brothers: Ronald (Diane) Greuel of Manitowoc and Roger Greuel of New Holstein; his sisters-in-law: Chun Greuel of Grafton and Nancy (Ronald) Senske of Omaha, NE.
