Robert "Nutty" Niederehe, 77, of Fond du Lac, passed away peacefully in his home on Friday, September 13, 2024. Nutty was born in Fond du Lac at Saint Agnes Hospital on December 25, 1946 to Wylma and Henry Niederehe. He was united in marriage to the love of his life, Julie Diener, at St. John's in Woodhull on September 21, 1985.

Throughout the years, Nutty held numerous jobs in the community before retiring from the Wisconsin Resource Center after 25 years. He was a devoted attendee of Holy Family Catholic Church, never missing a weekly mass, and was a regular at the Fond du Lac Family YMCA, enjoying both the fitness center and pools. Nutty was deeply committed to community service, having served as a Big Brother with Big Brothers Big Sisters of Fond du Lac County, a volunteer grandparent at Pier Elementary School, and a patient transport volunteer at Saint Agnes Hospital.

He put his family before everything else in his life, and never passed up an opportunity to spend time with his children and grandchildren. Nutty is survived by his wife Julie, daughters Amanda (Matt) Kelm and Andrea (Adam) Schultz, son Joe (Jeana) Niederehe, sisters-in-law Mary Niederehe, Beth Diener, and Sandy Diener, and six beautiful grandchildren, Charlie (his "buddy"), Mason, Calvin, Jordan, Cooper, and Leo.
