Robert M. Witthuhn, 87, of 519 Luco Road, Apt. 260, Lakeview Estates, Fond du Lac, died Friday, October 5, 2007, at St. Agnes Hospital, Fond du Lac. He was born on August 18, 1920, in Shiocton, a son of Arnold Witthuhn and Susie Johnson Witthuhn Andrews. On September 4, 1948, Robert married Lucy K. Colburn at the old Community United Methodist Church building in North Fond du Lac. Robert served in the United States Army during World War II in the South Pacific Theatre from September of 1942 to December of 1945. He retired from Wisconsin Bell Telephone Company in December of 1985. He was a member of Community Methodist Church, North Fond du Lac, and served as a treasurer on their church board and served on other committees. He was also a national member of AARP and a member of the local AARP Chapter 614. Robert was a member of American Legion Post 2930 of Portage, Wisconsin. He was a honorary life member of Communications Workers of America and a member of Dairyland Council Life Member Club of Telephone Pioneers of America and served as board president. He was active with the Boy Scouts of America and served as Cub Master and served on several committees.
