September 14, 1941 - April 3, 2023

Roger Paul Freiberg, 81, of Fond du Lac, died on Monday, April 3, 2023. Roger was born on September 14, 1941, in Fond du Lac, the son of Emmet and Gertrude (Cleveland) Freiberg, the fifth of their seven children. After graduating from Goodrich High School in 1960, Roger received his Bachelor of Science degree in 1964, from the University of Wisconsin - Oshkosh. Roger joined the United States Navy and was accepted to OCS at Newport, Rhode Island. He was commissioned in February 1964. Roger entered the USNR in September of 1964. He served on the aircraft carrier USS Bon Homme Richard in the South China Sea from 1965 to February 1969 during the Vietnam War. He received his Masters of Science degree from University of Wisconsin – LaCrosse in 1975.

Roger taught in the Fond du Lac School District for many years. He loved to hunt at his land in Clintonville and enjoyed many fishing trips out west. Roger was a member of St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church in Fond du Lac.

Roger is survived by his brother William Freiberg, his two sisters: Doris Werner and Jane Smet, his nieces and nephews and other family and friends. He is preceded in death by his parents, his siblings: Myrtle Trott, Ruth (Elmer) Fox, Eugene (Ruth) Freiberg, his sister in law Joann Freiberg and brother in law James Smet.
