Roger Clarence Wegner, 73, of W6528 E. Lone Elm Road, Van Dyne, died Saturday, July 16, 2011, at St. Agnes Hospital, Fond du Lac. He was born on March 3, 1938, in Oshkosh, son of Clarence and Mabel Beduhn Wegner. Roger was baptized at Zion Ev. Lutheran Church, Van Dyne, on March 25, 1938. He attended grade school at Howlett School, Town of Black Wolf. After the unexpected death of his father, Roger ran the family farm on Lone Elm Avenue in Van Dyne. He married Gilda Draeger at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac, on April 18, 1959, celebrating their 50th wedding anniversary in 2009. Roger served in the National Guard, being called into action to Ft. Lewis, WA. He worked for a short time at Morgan Door, Waite Carpet, and Tolibia Cheese. He was then employed at UW – Fond du Lac for thirty years, retiring in 2000. He is survived by his wife; his son Rev. Jeffrey Wegner, Rumford, RI; daughter Tamara (Scott) Monroe, Sun Prairie; and daughter Amy (Randy) Montgomery, Oshkosh; three grandchildren: Stephen (Brooke Borchert, fiancée) Monroe, Milwaukee; Thomas (Rebecca) Monroe, Lincoln, NE; and Rachel Monroe, Sun Prairie.
