Ronald B. Sadoff, 65, a resident of Fond du Lac, died unexpectedly on Tuesday, December 26, 2006. He was born on December 20, 1941, in Fond du Lac, a son of Arthur H. and Thelma C. Cravet Sadoff. Ron graduated from the University of Arizona with a degree in Business Administration in 1962. On July 24, 1982, he married Vikki Donker. He was Chief Executive Officer and Chairman of the Board of Badger Liquor Company, Inc. Ron was the current president of Temple Beth Israel; was currently a member on the Board of Directors of the Green Bay Packers and the American Bank of Fond du Lac. He was also a member of the Rotary Club of Fond du Lac, B.P.O.E. Elk's Lodge 57, the Fond du Lac Yacht Club and South Hills Country Club of which he was a past president. He previously served on the boards of Marian College and the Blandine House. Ron was an aviation enthusiast and avid boater. He enjoyed hunting and fishing throughout North America. He is survived by his wife, Vikki; two children: Michael of Fond du Lac and Stacey of Charlotte, North Carolina; his mother, Thelma Sadoff of Fond du Lac; a brother, Gary (Amy) Sadoff of Fond du Lac. He was preceded in death by his father on February 1, 1999. The visitation will be from 3-7 p.m. Thursday, December 28, 2006, at Mach Funeral Chapel. The funeral service will take place at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, December 29, 2006, at Temple Beth Israel, 149 East Division Street, Fond du Lac with Gary Wolfman officiating. Burial will follow in Rienzi Cemetery. Time may bring many changes to our lives, but through the years some things last and grow more precious- like the special joy of having you for a father and husband. We will miss you greatly.
