Ruth D. Ewerdt, 89, of 350 Winnebago Street, North Fond du Lac, and formerly of Brownsville, was welcomed into the arms of her Savior on Wednesday, March 18, 2009, at her home surrounded by family. She was born on March 23, 1919, in Fond du Lac, a daughter of William and Ida Luedtke Kutz. Ruth was baptized and confirmed at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac. She attended St. Peter's Lutheran School, Fond du Lac, and graduated from Winnebago Lutheran Academy, Class of 1937. She continued her education by receiving a teacher's certificate from Dodge County Normal School. On August 24, 1941, Ruth married Arnold O. Ewerdt at St. Paul's Lutheran Church parsonage in Brownsville. Ruth taught in numerous one-room schoolhouses in the Dodge County area, and also at St. John's Lutheran School, Newburg. She also taught kindergarten and second grade at St. Peter's Lutheran School, Fond du Lac, and kindergarten at St. Paul's Lutheran School, Brownsville. Christian education was very dear to Ruth's heart. Many former students have reflected on their memories of her as their teacher. Ruth was a former member of St. Paul's Ev. Lutheran Church, Brownsville, where she was a longtime member of the Ladies Aid and Dorcas Society. She was a member of St. Paul's Ev.
