Sheldon C. Tobey, 79, of Fond du Lac, died on Saturday, July 13, 2024, at Hospice Home of Hope.

Sheldon was born in Augusta, Maine, on January 19, 1945, to Maxine Tobey. When he was 12, they moved to Sarasota, FL. In 1964, Sheldon began his career at Kiekhaefer and drove boats in the gulf.
